Competitors Numbers

Athletes in Cycling, Race Walk, Road Race, Track & Field and Triathlon will pick up their competitor's numbers on the day of your event at the Event Check-In tent.

Road Closures

The following roads will be closed at the indicated times. These closings may effect your travel time to certain competition sites, so please take notice of the list of closings and make your plans accordingly.

June 7: 10K Cycling – Race begins at 9:30 a.m. Roads closed are Pearce Mill (in park), Babcock (from Pearce Mill to Ingomar), Ingomar (Babcock to Kummer) and Kummer (Ingomar to Pearce Mill). These roads will be closed from 9:15 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.

June 8: 20K Cycling – Race begins at 9:30 a.m. and there will be a rolling enclosure surrounding the riders. This will cause short-term closings of roads (1 to 2 minutes) as the group of riders circles the course. The race will go up Pearce Mill Road to the Red Belt, turn right to Babcock and back down Babcock to Pearce Mill Road. The race will last about 4 hours.

June 10: 5K Cycling – Race begins at 9:30 a.m. Roads closed are Lake Shore Drive, Pearce Mill Road (from Walter to Babcock), Babcock (from Pearce Mill to Ingomar), Ingomar (from Babcock to Kummer), and Kummer (from Ingomar to Lake Shore). The roads will be closed approximately 4 hours.

June 11: 5K Road Race – Race starts at 8:00 a.m. Roads closed are Lake Shore Drive, Pearce Mill Road (from Walter to Babcock), Babcock (from Pearce Mill to Ingomar), Ingomar (from Babcock to Kummer), and Kummer (from Ingomar to Lake Shore). The roads will be closed approximately 45 minutes.

June 11: 40K Cycling – Race starts at 9:30 a.m. and there will be a rolling enclosure surrounding the riders. This will cause short-term closings of roads (1 to 2 minutes) as the group of riders circles the course. The race will go up Pearce Mill Road to the Red Belt, turn right to Babcock and back down Babcock to Pearce Mill Road. The race will last approximately 5 hours.

June 13: 5K Race Walk – Race begins at 8:00 a.m. The only road closure will be Lake Shore Drive from Kummer to Pearce Mill. Road will be closed 1 hour.

June 13: 10K Road Race – Race begins at 9:30 a.m. Roads closed are Pearce Mill (in park), Babcock (from Pearce Mill to Ingomar), Ingomar (Babcock to Kummer), and Kummer (Ingomar to Pearce Mill). These roads will be closed from 9:15 a.m. until 10:15 a.m.
